American public servants and US advocates are recipients of the Dole-Harkin Award for distinction in public service to the global disability community, and an international disability rights advocate is honored for his/her outstanding work in advancing the rights, opportunities, and dignity of persons with disabilities. This year, our Dole-Harkin award recipient is Cara Yar Khan. Our International Advocate award recipient is Dr. Mina Mojtahedi.
